- Construction of a major breakwater and loading facilities to 70mtpa

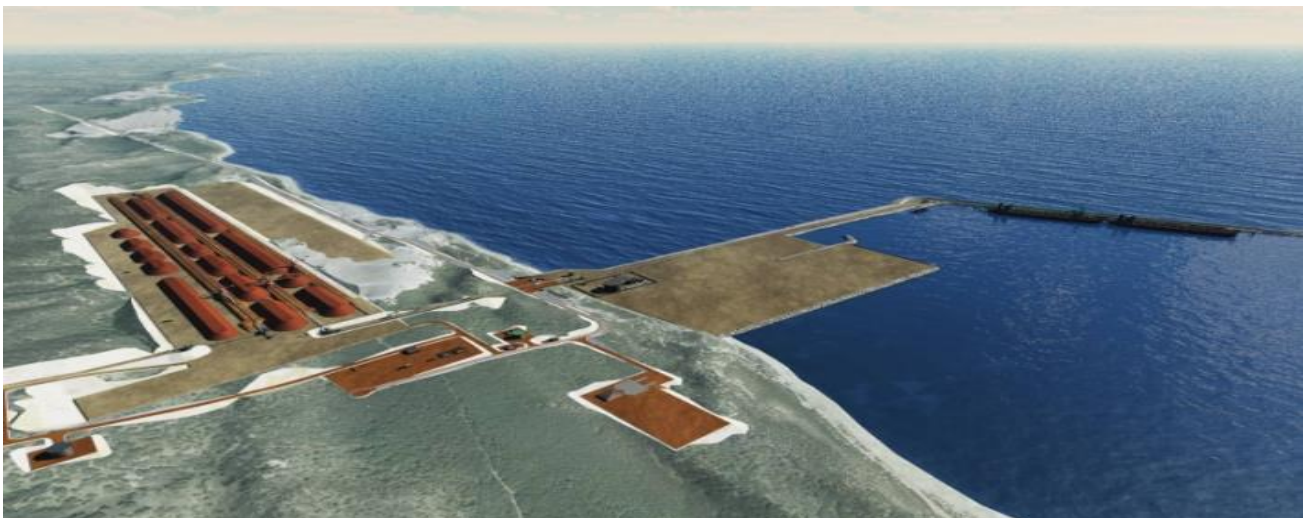
The Assignment
